

### **How to Support the Novi Public Library**

The Library is **supported annually by Novi taxpayers** through a dedicated millage. This millage supports the daily operations of the building, including services, resources, personnel, and maintenance. In 2007, a building bond was approved by voters to construct a new 59,000 sq. ft. library. In 2027, debt for the building will be completed, however, continued capital support to sustain its building and operations is ongoing and needed. Additional gifts and donations are essential to enhancing the core functions of the Library in the areas of collections, electronic resources, technology, programming/events, building and grounds, and outreach.

**Every donation, large or small, makes a difference** at NPL and is greatly appreciated. Donors are acknowledged through a thank you letter and recognition in the quarterly Engage magazine. Donations specifically for collections include a bookplate on the materials to be seen by readers. A donor wall located in the Library's lobby, recognizes gifts of \$2,000 and larger. Library Administration coordinates with donors to ensure a thoughtful experience.

73% and check outs of items have increased 71%. Thank you, Novi residents, for your amazing patronage and continuous use of the Library. 
